About MAP

The Museum of Art & Photography (MAP) is a new and innovative museum opening in Bangalore in 2022. MAP's mission is to take arts and culture to the heart of the community, making it accessible to the widest possible audience. MAP is a space for new ideas and conversations that are initiated through its collection.

MAP is the custodian of a growing collection of over 60,000 artworks, predominantly from South Asia and dating from the 10th century to the present. Its 44,000 sq. ft. flagship site will include five galleries, an auditorium, an art and research library, an education centre, a multimedia centre and a specialised research and conservation facility.

Since its inception, MAP has taken a 360-degree approach to accessibility and inclusion. Whether physical space or digital; whether it is policies or events, MAP is striving hard to ensure that the museum is a space for everyone irrespective of their background or ability.

Role Overview

The MAP Exhibitions team is looking for a researcher/writer for a period of six months (extendable) who will work on a digital project, *Museums Without Borders*.

The candidate will:

- Formulate engaging and cohesive scripts based on research for episodes
