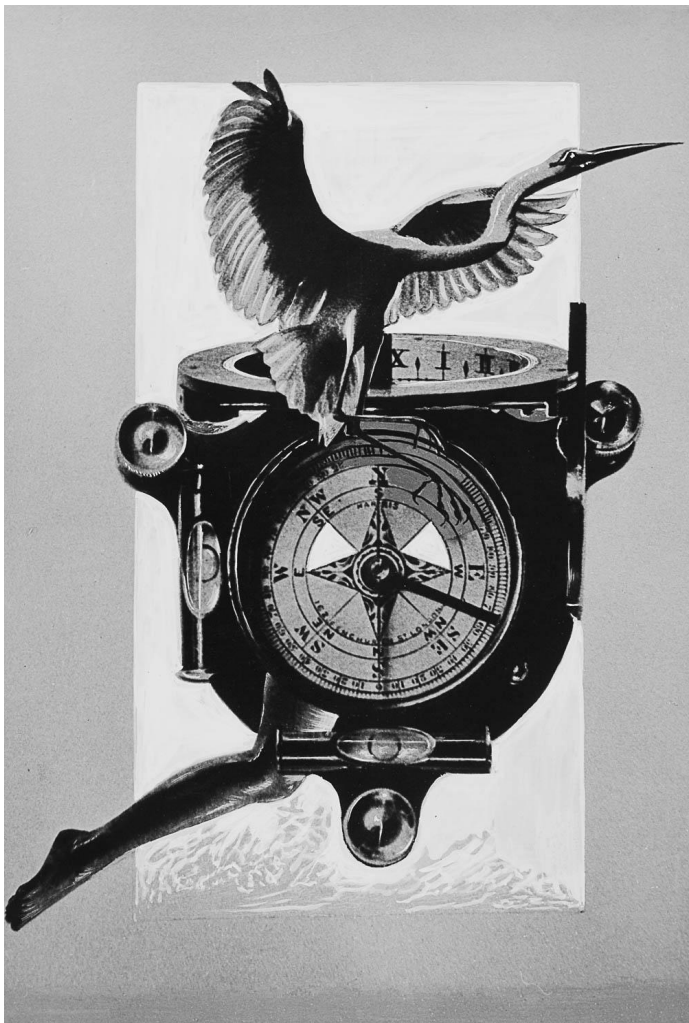


Activity Sheet: **Experimental collage**



A Collage is a form of picture making that is made by putting together ready materials such as newspaper cuttings, advertisements, photographs, etc. in a creative way.

Look at this collage by Jyoti Bhatt. It brings objects that already have their own meaning together but are put together to create a new meaning.

- What meaning can you make of a bird, a compass and a human leg put together?
- Can you give your own interpretation to it?

We can think of an interpretation like 'direction in life' because the compass talks about direction, birds have a great sense of direction and as humans we need direction in life.

CREATE.

Now can you get inspired by Jyoti Bhatt and try your hands at creating an experimental collage that brings together similar, random objects but can form a bigger idea?

For this you will need

Materials:

- Old magazines, newspapers or any other books with printed images,
- A4 sheet for base
- Scissors
- Glue

Method:

Step 1: Pull out old magazines and newspapers and choose different images featuring objects, vehicles, animals, people etc.

Step 2. Cut along the outline of these figures that you have chosen to form a cutout.

Step 3. Now you can take creative liberty and experiment in arranging these different figures together. Remember to make the most uncommon combinations to get the best results.

Step 4: Once you feel your composition looks interesting, use glue and stick the images on the base to make a final picture.

Now you have created a creative, experimental collage using ready pictures.
