### Summary

The candidate will aid the department in cataloguing, research, digitisation, care and storage of the *Haveli Collection*. The collection is broadly divided into textiles and costumes from India and around the world and includes woodblocks, swatches, design sketches, brochures, letterheads, visiting cards and photo-albums. The candidate will support the department's goal to provide access to the museum's vast collection to various internal and external stakeholders.

### Main Duties and Responsibilities

- Accurately catalogue textiles and objects from the Haveli Collection.
- Update artwork information on MAP's Collections Management System.
- Conduct accurate and complete inventory of the collection.
- Support in any required rehousing of the collection and artwork movement.
- Any other duties assigned by the line manager with prior discussion and agreement.

## **Required Competencies**

- Demonstrated knowledge of archival/collections management principles and practices.
- Self-motivated individual with the ability to work under pressure, manage heavy workloads and to meet tight deadlines, paying close attention to detail and quality of work.
